Booking your child's place at the UEA Sportspark Holiday Club is quick and easy via our UEA online store.


Step-by-Step Booking Guide:

- 1. Visit the UEA Online Store (https://store.uea.ac.uk)
- 2. Find the Holiday Club Event Page by heading to 'Conferences and Events' > 'Sport and Commercial Services' > 'Holiday Club'










4. Next, you will select the dates that you wish to book. Once you are happy with your selection, you will confirm your items by clicking 'Confirm Items'.







7. Should you wish to book multiple children on to our Holiday Club, you will click 'Continue Shopping' and repeat the previous steps.


If you have completed your selections for all children, you will review these selections and the relevant charges. Once you are happy with your order, you will click 'Proceed to Checkout'.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the UEA Holiday Club?

The UEA Holiday Club is a fun, safe, and engaging childcare programme for children aged 4–13, running during school holidays. We offer a wide range of indoor and outdoor activities including lots of sports, arts and crafts and activities!

Who can attend the Holiday Club?

The club is open to all children. Children must be aged 4-13 and able to attend without additional 1:1 support (unless arranged in advance with SCD coordinators)

When does the Holiday Club run?

We operate during the school holidays, including Easter, Summer, and other half terms. Specific dates and availability are published via our social media and UEA Online store pages!

What are the opening times?

Our standard day runs from 08:00 to 18:00, with drop-off between 8:00-9:15am and pick-up between 15:30-18:00.

Where is the Holiday Club held?

The Holiday Club is based on UEA campus, typically using facilities such as the Sportspark and Congregation Hall (Summer Holiday Club). Specific locations will all be confirmed upon booking.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What activities are on offer?

We offer a diverse programme including:

- Team sports and games
- Arts and crafts
- Gymnastics
- Swimming

How do I book a place?

Bookings can be made online through our UEA Holiday Club Online Store. Places are limited and fill quickly, so early booking is advised.

Do you accept childcare vouchers?

Unfortunately we do not. Due to the fact we are not OFSTED registered we are unable to accept childcare vouchers.

What should my child bring?

Please pack:

A packed lunch and snacks (If you have a no lunch booking) A refillable water bottle

Weather-appropriate clothing (e.g. waterproof coat, sun hat) Swimwear and towel (if swimming is scheduled)

What if my child has additional needs?

We aim to be as inclusive as possible. Please contact us before booking to discuss your child's individual requirements so we can ensure appropriate support is in place if needed!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if my child is feeling unwell?

If your child is unwell, we ask that they stay at home to rest and prevent the spread of illness. If a child becomes ill during the day, we will contact you immediately to arrange collection.

Is there a behaviour policy?

We promote positive behaviour through encouragement and clear expectations. In cases of challenging behaviour, we will work closely with parents/carers to resolve issues in a supportive way. Persistent issues may result in a child not being able to attend Holiday Club.

Are meals or snacks provided?

No, children need to bring their own packed lunch and snacks for the day if they do not have a lunch provided by us. Please where possible ensure all food is nut-free due to allergy risks.

Can I drop off or collect my child outside of the set times?

Yes you absolutely can, you just have to let the team know at drop off to ensure we can have your child ready for collection.

How are children grouped during the day?

Children are generally grouped by age to ensure activities are age-appropriate and enjoyable for all:

Red Group, Blue Group, Orange Group, Green Group
